



Rapid Response Team Commitment

Becoming a member of the Rapid Response Team takes on a whole new level of commitment for an individual. Listed below are some of the requirements for joining the Rapid Response Team.

1. This team trains one day per month (more training opportunities may be available). Rapid Response Team members must be willing to participate in at least 75% of these training sessions. Trainings are typically held in or around McKinney, TX.
2. Annual dues for Rapid Response Team members are \$100.00. Team members that make the commitment to the Rapid Response Team will be charged a one-time \$65 membership upgrade fee and their annual dues subscription will be increased to \$100.
3. The uniform and personal field gear needed for a Rapid Response Team member can cost between \$200-\$500 to obtain. You must be willing to make these purchases prior to becoming deployment ready for this team.
4. Rapid Response Team members are called upon to respond to incidents with little to no notice. You must be willing to seek permission from their employer to leave work with short notice on a true emergency response.
5. The Rapid Response Team meets monthly to discuss business matters and plan training events. Team members must commit to regularly attending these meetings. Meetings are typically held in or around McKinney, TX.

I have read the above and understand the additional commitment that will be required of me to join the Rapid Response Team and will do my part to fulfill this commitment. I understand that my commitment or my lack of commitment not only affects me, but also has an impact on the entire team that is counting on me. If at anytime I feel that I am unable to fulfill this commitment, I will submit my resignation to MDR leadership. I also understand that if at anytime it is observed that my level of commitment to the Rapid Response Team is not at the level it should be, that I may be asked to shift my membership to an area on the team that better suits my availability.
